## Call for Abstracts for Advanced Track, 38th Annual Veterinary Dental Forum, September 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Palm Springs, California.

The Advanced track will continue on its modified schedule for the 2024 Veterinary Dental Forum in an effort to bring more specialized, in depth and updated information for attendees. Major changes include designated topics per day, keynote speakers per topic to increase the comparative knowledge base, and shorter lectures to retain attendee engagement.

This day will focus on a keynote speaker who is an endodontist coupled with veterinary speakers sharing their varied experience with diagnostic and treatment modalities for endodontics.

We invite interested parties to submit a structured abstract limited to 250 words describing the proposed topic. **Topics should be confined to the specific title/theme of the day (i.e., oral medicine or endodontics).** Please note that not all abstracts will be accepted. Each lecture will be 20-25 min to allow for a short discussion.

We encourage all clinicians and researchers to submit proposals for these important tracks.
